Founded in 1994 with the vision of building the first major independent Canadian midstream company, AltaGas has evolved into a diversified operator and developer of gas, power and utility infrastructure. Our gas infrastructure touches more than 2 Bcf/d of natural gas in Canada. Our gas business gathers, processes, transports, stores and markets natural gas and natural gas liquids.



Extraction

Our extraction assets include interests in six extraction plants in Canada. With a net inlet capacity of 1.6 Bcf/d, our plants reprocess natural gas to recover ethane and natural gas liquids (NGLs). Our facilities are strategically located near pipeline transmission systems that transport natural gas to end markets.








Transmission

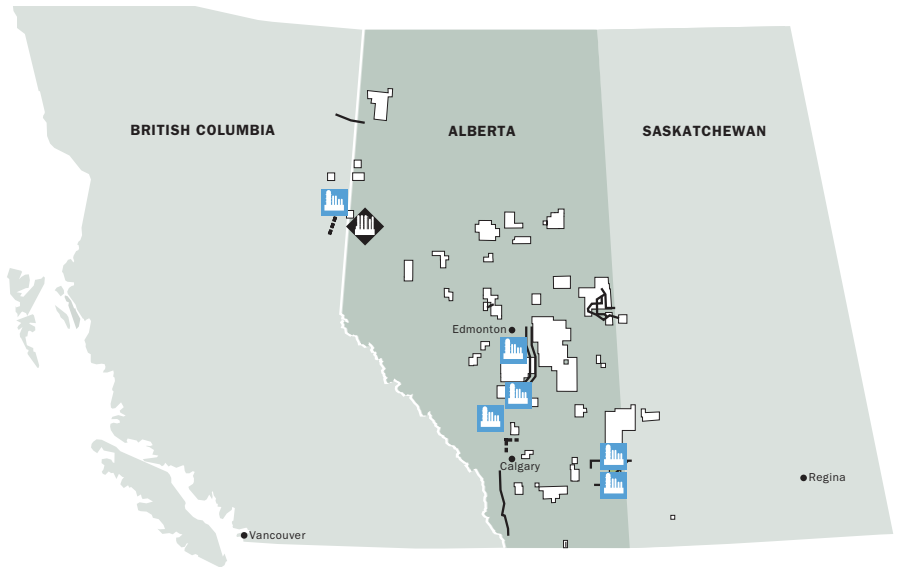
Our transmission pipelines deliver natural gas and NGLs to distribution systems, end users and other downstream pipelines. We own and operate five natural gas transmission systems with a combined transportation capacity of approximately 554 Mmcf/d and three NGL pipelines with a combined capacity of 151,600 Bbls/d.

Field Gathering & Processing

We have more than 70 gathering and processing facilities in 31 operating areas in western Canada that process raw natural gas to remove impurities, and in some cases, to extract higher value-added NGLs for sale. Our 6,500 km network of gathering and sales lines provides producers in the Western Canada Sedimentary Basin with quick access to North American markets for their natural gas.

Natural Gas Storage

We also provide natural gas storage through our 50 percent ownership of the 5.3 Bcf Sarnia natural gas storage facility connected to the Dawn hub in eastern Canada.

Energy Services

In addition to our gas assets, AltaGas offers gas procurement, management and optimization services. Our Energy Services teams provide support for the infrastructure-based businesses by contracting supply and shrinkage gas for our extraction facilities. We also contract and resell capacity on our transmission pipelines and provide gas control services to balance gas flows. Additionally, Energy Services markets gas for customers and provides energy procurement services for large industrial and utility gas users.
