AltaGas understands water is an essential resource for our company, people, communities, the economy, and the environment. This framework emphasizes our commitment to manage our water use in a responsible manner, and abide by applicable water related laws, regulations and permit requirements.

Scope

The Company's commitment to responsible water usage applies to all persons involved in the Company's operations including, but not limited to, Company employees, officers, directors, contractors, and consultants. Our commitment to responsible water usage also extends to our value chain, and we use our relationships with our contractors, suppliers, and other business partners to encourage and promote the principles of this approach.

OUR APPROACH

AltaGas strives to:

- Acknowledge that water is a shared resource and adopt practices to minimize our impacts on water supplies;
- Work to minimize the Company's water use, recycle and reuse whenever practical either ourselves or third party partners, and manage water discharge from our operations when feasible;
- Be prepared, in those areas where we operate, for incidents of drought, flooding, or other disruptions in water supply;
- Work with our stakeholders, including water and environmentally focused agencies, government, regulators, local communities including local indigenous communities, experts, non-governmental organizations, and other businesses to support water efficiency actions, technology and programs;
- Where applicable, evaluate water impacts and risks in the planning, development, construction, operation and asset retirement stages of our operations;
- Where applicable, measure and report on our use of water, and the water-related risks and opportunities for our business;
- Where applicable, implement innovative water management and water treatment solutions to protect water impacted by our operations; and
- Ensure that water discharged from our facilities meets or exceeds permit requirements and applicable federal, state and provincial regulations.
