



2026 David Cornhill Scholarship Application

The David Wallace Cornhill Scholarship is named for AltaGas' founder and honors outstanding students who create social impact in their communities and demonstrate our core values.



Applicant Eligibility

- Dependents of **regular** employees of the AltaGas group of companies, inclusive of: Petrogas, SEMCO, and Washington Gas.
 - Dependents are defined as any individual between the ages of 17 and 25 at the time of the close of the application period, who an employee of the company is financially responsible for as defined by the applicable tax authority.
 - A company employee is defined for this purpose as any individual who is a regular full-time or part-time employee of AltaGas, or any AltaGas subsidiary. *(no required minimum length of tenure for employees)*
 - The dependents of contractors are not eligible to apply for this Scholarship Program.

- Applicants must legally be residents of Canada and/or the United States at the time of the close of the application period.
- Applicants must be willing to provide proof of non-conditional acceptance to a government accredited, post-secondary program with registration in the program commencing Fall 2026, prior to the Scholarship being issued.
- Eligibility does not guarantee a Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant.
- Individuals who have previously received the David Cornhill Scholarship award are not eligible to apply to receive a second David Cornhill Scholarship award.
- Awardees must be willing to provide a photo of themselves, sign a photo-release form, and provide a quote about the impact that receiving the Scholarship award will have for them, by July 15, 2026 sent to the listed Scholarship award contact.



The scholarship application is open to eligible dependents of company employees in all areas of our operations and supports students between the ages of 17 and 25 who are entering a government accredited post-secondary program. Two scholarships are available, each valued at \$3,000.

Application Package Requirements (Please Read Carefully)

- All contents of the application package must be sent electronically to community.investment@altagas.ca.
- **The closing date for applications is midnight MDT, May 15, 2026.**
- The application package must be submitted by the applicant themselves; it cannot be submitted by a parent or another individual on behalf of the applicant.
- The email with the application package attachment(s) should have the subject line FIRST NAME, LAST NAME – 2026 DAVID CORNHILL SCHOLARSHIP PACKAGE.
- Eligible applicants must fully complete the provided application form.
- Eligible applicants must provide a pdf copy of a communication of acceptance (conditional or non-conditional) from a government accredited post-secondary institution, with studies commencing in Fall 2026 as part of the application package.
- **Eligible applicants must provide a properly formatted short essay in pdf format, no longer than 1000 words, answering the following question:**
 - How have you engaged in your community and contributed to positive social impact through your personal engagement? Think of examples where you have volunteered in your community, demonstrated leadership through school council/club opportunities, and sports or extracurricular activities. How did your participation impact the community and what did you learn from the experience?

- Eligible applicants must provide a letter of reference for at least one of the community engagements examples that they cite in their essay. More than one letter of reference will be accepted and considered if provided but is not a requirement and may not increase the likelihood of an applicant's potential to be selected for the Scholarship award.
- All the above documentation must be included in one submission email. Applicants who provide the required documentation by sending more than one submission email containing various components of the application package will be considered to have not met the specifications for a complete application.
- Applicants are not required to provide a transcript of their grades to be eligible for the Scholarship award.
- Applicants are not required to demonstrate financial need to be eligible for the Scholarship award.
- Applicants are entirely responsible for ensuring that their application package is complete and meets the specifications communicated.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Are dependent(s) of regular Part Time employees of AltaGas, or any AltaGas subsidiary eligible to apply?

A: Yes

Q: Are dependent(s) of contractors providing services to AltaGas, or any AltaGas subsidiary eligible to apply?

A: No

Q: If a contractor becomes an employee *after* the Scholarship program application period opens, but prior to the Scholarship program application period closing can their dependent(s) apply for the Scholarship?

A: Yes, provided that AltaGas HR will verify this change in employment status for the employee, that the applicant meets all other eligibility criteria, and that the application is received no later than the application period deadline.

Q: If an employee leaves the company *after* their dependent(s) have applied for the Scholarship but prior to the Scholarship award being issued, will AltaGas still consider the applicant eligible?

A: Yes, if the employee leaves the company under regular circumstances *after* their dependent(s) have submitted a *fully complete* application for the Scholarship, but prior to the recipient selection, they will still be considered eligible.

Q: If the applicant has applied to the Scholarship in the past, but has been unsuccessful in receiving the award, can they re-apply?

A: Yes. If an individual has applied to the Scholarship in the past, and still meets all other eligibility requirements but has not received a previous Scholarship award payment, then this individual can re-apply for the Scholarship. Re-application does not guarantee a Scholarship award.

Q: If the applicant has been a previous recipient of the Scholarship award can they re-apply to receive another Scholarship award in a future year, if they still meet all other eligibility requirements?

A: No. If an individual has already once received the Scholarship award, they are not eligible to apply to receive the Scholarship Award again, regardless of if they still currently meet all other eligibility criteria.

Q: Must the applicant be entering their first year of study in any government accredited post-secondary program?

A: The applicant can be entering *any* year of study in any government accredited post-secondary program. Should they be selected as a recipient they must be willing to provide proof of non-conditional acceptance/enrollment continuation in a program where they are registered to commence study for Fall Semester 2026.

Q: Are there restrictions on which post-secondary programs of study the applicant must be registered for to receive the Scholarship?

A: Yes, the post-secondary institution must be a verifiable government accredited program. There are no restrictions on the area of study, the length of the program, or the type of accreditation or degree that the applicant may be conferred upon completion.

Q: If the applicant has been accepted and plans to attend post-secondary studies at a government accredited program outside of Canada and the United States are they still eligible to receive the Scholarship award?

A: Yes, if it is possible for the Scholarship administrator to confirm that a post-secondary institution is government accredited, and if the applicant is willing to provide proof of non-conditional acceptance to a program with study commencing in Fall 2026. There is no restriction on which country the applicant chooses to study to be eligible to receive the Scholarship award.

Q: If the applicant has already been conferred a previous accreditation or degree or has previously partially completed a post-secondary program, and have been accepted into another government accredited post-secondary program commencing in Fall 2026 are they still eligible?

A: Yes, provided that the applicant still meets all other eligibility requirements, especially the age requirement.

Q: Must the applicant provide proof that they are registered for full-time studies in their program to be eligible?

A: No. Provided that the applicant still meets all other eligibility requirements, it doesn't matter if the applicant is planning full-time or part-time studies.

Q: If the applicant has confirmation of conditional acceptance at the time of application, but subsequently chooses to defer study or is declined full acceptance into their program prior to AltaGas issuing the Scholarship award payment, can the applicant (if chosen as an award recipient) still receive the award?

A: No. If a selected applicant chooses to defer study to later than Fall 2026 or is declined full acceptance into their program prior to the award payment being issued, then the selected applicant will become ineligible to receive the award payment and another applicant will be chosen. This applicant can then re-apply in a future year if they still meet all other eligibility requirements. Best practice would be for the applicant to notify the Scholarship contact as soon as they make the decision to defer study, or as soon as they receive notification from their post-secondary program that they have been declined full acceptance.

Q: If the applicant has been accepted (conditionally or non-conditionally) to more than one post-secondary program, must they choose to attend the post-secondary program that they used as information in their original Scholarship application?

A: No. If an applicant has been accepted (conditionally or non-conditionally) to more than one post-secondary program, it is their choice on which program to register for Fall 2026. The requirement is that prior to receiving the Scholarship award, the recipient must be willing to provide proof of full acceptance and registration for Fall 2024 to any government accredited, post-secondary institution.

Q: If the application package is incomplete or does not meet the communicated requirements prior to the close of the application period, will the applicant be notified to ensure that they provide the missing documentation or update their application to meet the application requirements?

A: No. It is an applicant's responsibility to resubmit a complete application package prior to the deadline, or the applicant will be disqualified from consideration for the Scholarship award.

Q: If I apply and want to make an update or entirely re-submit my application prior to the close of the application period what should I do?

A: If you need to resubmit your complete application package for any reason it must be done prior to the close of the application period. Please email the resubmission to the provided Scholarship award contact and include the following in the subject line: LAST NAME, FIRST NAME RESUBMISSION and the date of your resubmission.
